Q How is this education credit better than a tax deduction?

A This credit gives you a dollar-for-dollar reduction in the amount you owe in Georgia taxes. For example, if you donate \$1,000, then your tax bill would be reduced by the full \$1,000.¹

Q How does this impact my current tax withholdings?

A Participation in this program does not automatically change your withholding amount. You will realize the benefits of your donation when you file your year-end taxes.

Q If I'm the parent of a TDSA student, do I receive Fair-Share credit for participation in this program?

A Yes, you will receive a dollar-for-dollar Fair-Share credit for each dollar you invest in the program. For example, if you donate \$1,500 this year, you will get \$1,500 Fair-Share credit.

Q If I'm in the Alternative Minimum Tax (AMT) bracket how does this program impact me?

A Great News! You will receive a reduction in taxes greater than your donation.

Q What determines a child's eligibility for a scholarship?

A In addition to satisfying TDSA's standard enrollment criteria, a child must be a Georgia resident transferring from a public school or starting kindergarten for the first time.

Education Expense Credit Program

Thanks to the recently enacted Georgia Education Expense Credit program, you or your company are able to donate to our scholarship fund now and literally receive a dollar-for-dollar tax refund within a year of your donation. In doing so, you are helping a child receive an exceptional Jewish education with a money back guarantee.¹

Participation is limited. Act now before the annual state-wide cap is reached!

What is the maximum amount I can contribute?

- Up to \$1,000 for a single individual
- Up to \$2,500 for a married couple, an S corp, or LLC
- Up to 75% of a C corp's total income tax liability

Step By Step Instructions

Pre-Qualification – Complete the enclosed form and mail to Torah Day School of Atlanta. Additional forms are available at www.TorahDay.org. No payment is required at this time.

Approval – Within approximately 30 days you should receive your approval form from the Georgia Department of Revenue.

Donate to help Jewish children – You then have 30 days from the approval date to make your donation. Please make checks payable to Apogee with "TDSA" in the memo line and mail back to TDSA with a copy of your approval form.

Get your refund – You will receive a confirmation form once your donation has been processed. Submit this confirmation form along with a copy of the approval form with your tax return(s).

Note 1: Actual net refund on your donation ranges from 96% up to 129%, depending on how your taxes are filed. Please consult with your tax advisor regarding your specific circumstances.
